Not often do you get the opportunity to buy a piece of Toodyay History as this. Greens Cottage, so named after the original owner Police Constable Ebenezer Green, has been a well established property within the Shire of Toodyay since the 1860s.

Built from locally sourced brick, the home has verandahs front and rear, wide entrance passage way dividing the large living room, kitchen and bedrooms of the original cottage. Later extensions have added a further bedroom and a bathroom plus laundry facilities.

The present owner has lived in the house for the last 35 years and now it is time for another family to enjoy the history of this residence and refresh the interior to its former glory.

The large rooms of the original cottage boast beautiful floorboards, high ceilings and spacious rooms. The classic small paned sash windows create the ambiance of a home from a bygone era.

The land surrounding the cottage offers a good size front and rear garden, ample off street parking for the family cars plus room for a workshop /garage.
